

Coverage includes the country in its entirety along with many of its islands including an inset map of Cocos Island (Isla de Coco), the UNESCO World Heritage Site. An inset of capital San Jose, provides in-depth detail of the capital, including notable buildings, churches, embassies, parks and churches. Recreation and adventure activities marked along the country's shorelines including areas for surfing, diving and fishing as well as labeled natural features, such as freshwater and saltwater swamps, mangroves and reefs. Be Forewarned! I recently traveled to Costa Rica with this map. In one area (Monteverde) particularly the map was inaccurate. It showed "paths" (per the legend) that are actually now graded and graveled roads. These can be easily traversed by even non-4wd vehicles (buses & compact cars). Luckily, I had a local guide. When I showed him the map, he expressed surprise at how "out-of-date" it was. The map is dated 2002 and was supposedly revised in 2010. However, according to my local guide these paths had been roads since well before the revision. If I had depended solely on the map, I would have traveled MANY miles out of my way to reach my destinations. The misinformation provided on the parts of the map I used lead me to doubt the accuracy of the remainder of the map. Truly, I now will be extremely cautious in depending upon any National Geographic travel map. I wrote to National Geographic Society Maps after my return home. As of several weeks later, I have not received the courtesy of a reply. Please do not depend upon this map if you travel to Costa Rica!

National Geographic -- do I have to say more about the thoroughness of the quality of their maps? Additionally, the waterproofing feature serves to preserve the map, unlike other maps where the corners and creases tend to tear or fracture with repeated foldings. I wouldn't waste my money on anything less.

The detail of the map was even better than I expected. The map even showed railroads which haven't existed for 40 or 50 years. Totally love the map.
