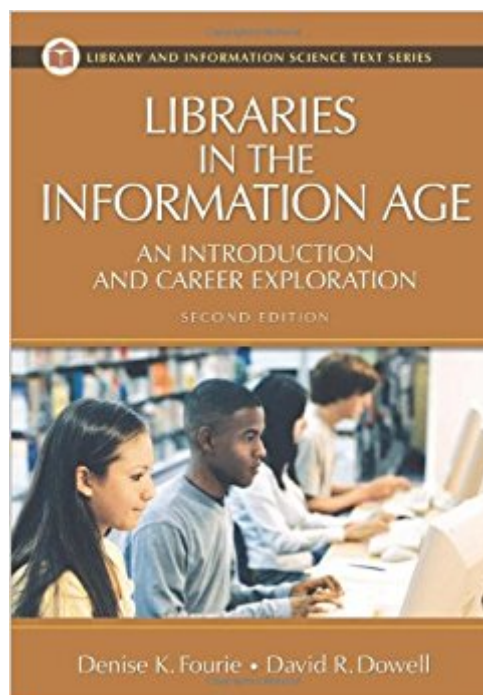


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Libraries In The Information Age: An Introduction And Career Exploration, 2nd Edition (Library And Information Science Text)
