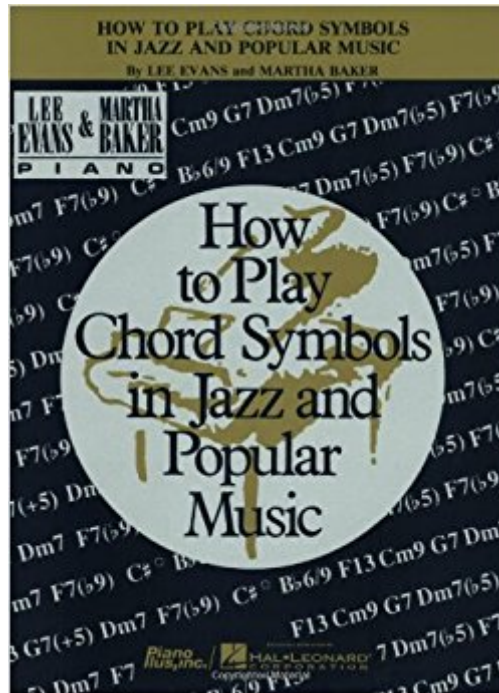

This book is loaded with chords for use in playing piano and composing, for yourself and for teaching your students.

This book is organized perfectly starting with I, IV & V7 in C major and then progressing through the different keys and inversion, ultimately taking you through advance Jazz chords. The order allows for self-study but will also allow for a piano teacher to expound on it. It does require that you understand the scale and intervals. Without that, this will be very difficult. As a piano teacher, I am starting this book for a student that is in Book 2 of the Alfred Basic Piano Library. That is the absolute earliest I would start a student because by this point, they have learned the diatonic intervals. I will have to teach the chromatic intervals (Major, minor, and Perfect) before he will fully understand the advanced stuff. But I highly recommend this book for an intermediate to advanced pianist who wants to strengthen his skills in reading chord charts and lead sheets (fakebooks).
