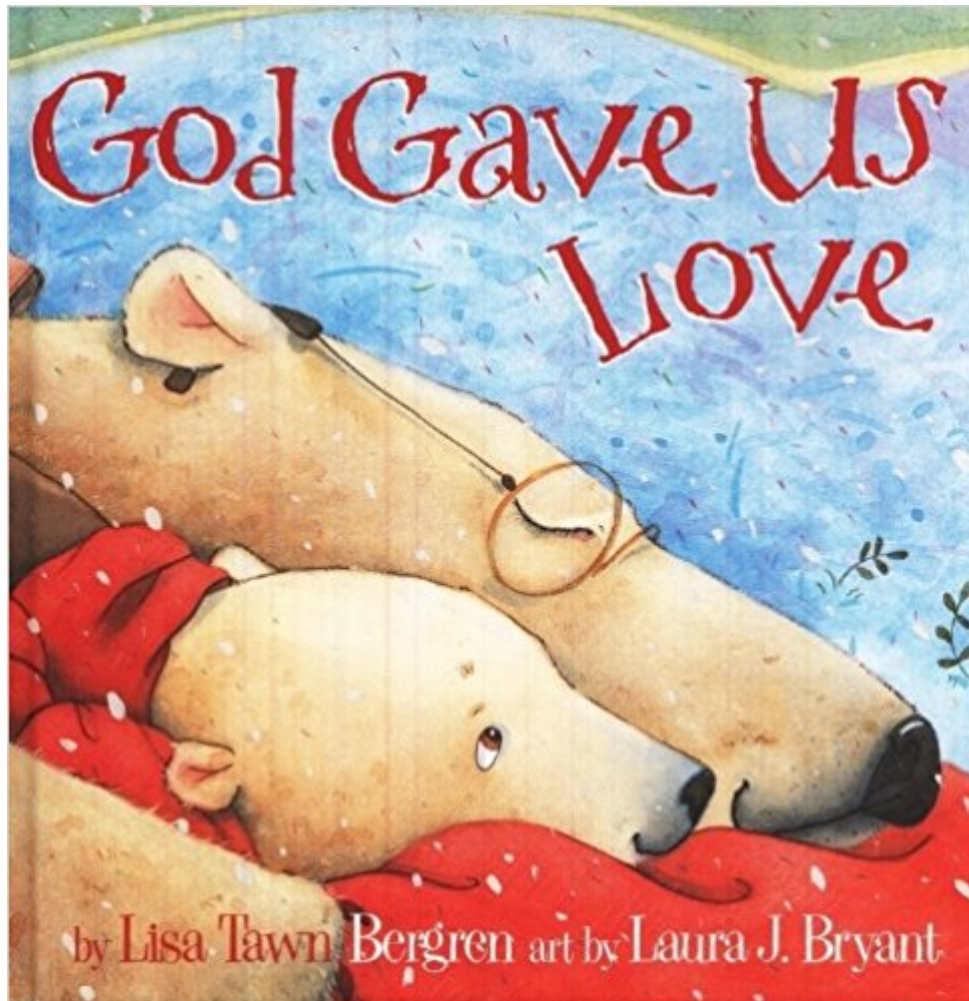

The story is a great one between a grandpa and young cub about how we are to love others and how God also loves us even more. Great story about love, faith and the perfect love of God who gave us His son. Pros: great story, colorful pictures. cons: the story at one point goes from grandpa cub talking about families to suddenly they are having a group family hug with little cubs parents, which causes the story to not flow well at that one point.

Very cute. Describes different kinds of love; such as the love between mother & father; parents & children. It also shows understanding in that people are imperfect & can sometimes bother us, making us "love them, but not like them" at times, without teaching kids that that is okay. Great way of showing how God's love is perfect.

My 5 year old daughter loved Bergren's book *God Gave us You*, but this one I bought for Valentine's Day and she doesn't read it over and over like the other one. Maybe because I bought the kindle edition? It's still a cute book, though. I like that it is a Christian story!
