I have never been disappointed by a book written by this author, and this one is no exception. However, you always have to have a least favorite in any group of books, and this one is probably mine. I'm not sure why; perhaps both hero and heroine, although delightful people, are too privileged all the way through. There is a subplot concerning several villainous servants that seems

to belong in another book because it pretty much goes nowhere. Also, the only real villain of the piece has a change of heart so quick, so complete, and so unwarranted that you are thrown for a loop. Still, even a mediocre story by this author is worth your time.

The summary of the story is good. The H is a bit wounded from his failed relationship with his ex when he meets the h and helps her get away from her kidnappers. He is reluctant to get involved with her and only half-heartedly agrees to offer for her after they spend the night alone together. The h isn't willing to settle for anything other than true love and so she goes off to London to have her season. The H realises that he may well be interested in her after all and follows her. It's a cute clean short story and I recommend it.

Every book I have read by S. G. Rogers has been very enjoyable and this book is no exception. When trying to be kidnapped, Jillian manages to escape and is helped out by a bearded rifle holding man. The twist and turns go from there. Enjoy another great story of a season in London.

Well researched and evocative of the time period, Rogers has written a tale of a young Englishwoman of marriageable age who must overcome some potentially reputation damaging rumors as she is about to enter London society. The story illustrates how difficult it was for girls and families at this time to maintain a sterling character in order to land a highly prized husband from a good family. Full of adventure as well as romance, action and tenderness, "Ice Captain's Daughter" is sure to entertain readers who are looking to read a sweet, romantic novel.

This story is set in a later time period than I'm usually accustomed to, after the telephone has been invented and after Queen Victoria's husband has died. The main characters are well-developed and

consistent as well as likeable. They have the usual misunderstandings along the way but overcome them in the end. Although it was a short read (about 2 hours for me), it felt like a complete story, not rushed like some novellas are. I particularly liked the way even the villians were multi-dimensional and how at least a couple of them were redeemed in the end. I will be reading more books by this author.

This was a nice clean historical romance. Jillian's servants turn on her while traveling to London for her season, and she is rescued by the hero. Because they are alone together, he feels compelled to offer her marriage, and she feels just as compelled to turn him down since she wants a love match. He has given up on society, but after meeting Jillian he follows her to London. His former love does all she can to throw obstacles in their path, but as in any good old-fashioned romance, happily ever after is inevitable. The author has included enough detail here to make the story different from others. Jillian's famous ice-captain father (who makes a late appearance in the story) is one such detail.

I thoroughly enjoyed this book! This is my third book to read from this author and I just adore her...I will definitely be reading more books from her in the future.
