

A thematic index lists all the sites and addresses featured in this guide.

I recently went to Berlin for a short trip. This guidebook was really great. It was lightweight and small enough to fit in my pocket. The fold out maps were easy to read and contained just the right amount of information. One downside to this book - it doesn't provide suggested itineraries or detailed information about the sites. So I chose to do my research and plan my day ahead of time. But once I was out and about this book was perfect to help me find my intended destinations, decide on impromptu stops, and find a spot to eat. I highly recommend this book if you are looking for something small and light to carry around with you. The fold out maps are great!

I love these guides--they seem to be out of print, which makes me sad--Knopf, please revive this series!

While I do like the compact size of this book, I have two complaints about it: (1) the font is VERY small and difficult to read. The subway map is pretty much useless, and (2) the city is split in to zones, and while this way to organize a city map is generally OK, there are major portions of the main city that are not covered in one of the assigned zones. Overall, I would not recommend this book unless you plan in the center of Berlin and if you have microscopic eye sight. I'm off to look for another map right now.

I use these guides everywhere in the world. They are the perfect size and have maps that fold out that you can see. I am never lost once I started traveling with Knopf Map Guides. The first time I was in New York it was a God send. We are planning trips to Paris and Barcelona. I have already located where our hotels are and know where we can go and get back "home."

For its purpose, the best traveler's guide we have yet discovered. We have used them for Paris, Rome, London, Madrid and now Berlin, and they have become a necessary purchase for any new
