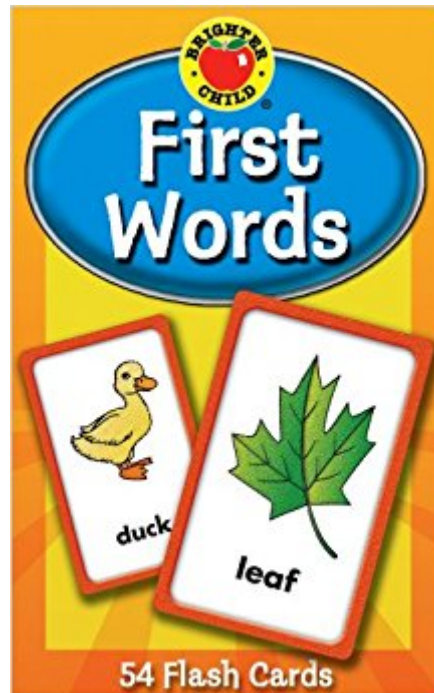

I purchased these cards for my 21 month old son. He doesn't talk as much as I feel he should, so we've started using the flash cards daily. The flash cards are printed on a thick, durable material. The pictures are bright and have the picture and word written below. (* See picture below of several

of the cards) There are a lot of cards with basic "starter" words, such as: duck, sock, cow, key, girl, egg, flower, tree, circle, goat, ring, house, turtle, sun, fox, ect. My son gets excited when we do the flashcards and since we've been using them daily, he's starting to be able to pronounce things a little clearer. I would recommend these to anyone with kids ages 1-5! I'm very happy with the purchase of this product.

My son is 3 years old and has autism. He is non-verbal. I got these cards to work with him and he loves them. He will actually sit down and let me go through the whole stack. He hasn't repeated any words yet but he can point to certain ones if I ask "where's the duck..." . I am confident he will be speaking soon though! :)

My 3 year old has central hypotonia and gets speech therapy twice a week. Her therapist has cards to use with her, but my daughter enjoys them so much I wanted some for her at home. The words are a good variety of sounds, and the pictures are bold and colorful enough for her to find engaging. Today her therapist used them and she liked them better than her own! I definitely recommend

These cards are ok. If I'd been able to go through them in person, I wouldn't have bought them. There are just too many cards that just don't make sense for helping a young child associate an image with a word, like a car that looks nothing like a car, and a pig that's standing on its back feet and looks like it's dancing--try translating that image into real life!

I began using these with my son at about 12 months. He's now 17 months and still loves these cards. The pictures are bright and the size is perfect. Although the card stock used is sufficient, it would have been nice if it were a tad thicker so that it wouldn't be bent as easily. But that's not enough of an issue to reduce the amount of stars I'm giving these fun flash cards.

Brought these to practice with my 21 month old. They were very informative and he immediately went and grabbed shoes when I showed him the card. He is bilingual as English is my 4th language but he is able to recognize most of the cards and words.. We will keep practicing because I want him in preschool at 3 years old.

I bought these educational cards for my 1 year old, so we could start working on our words, numbers and colors. He absolutely loved them! We spent a lot of time looking at the cards and

picking out our favorite ones.. He even liked them so much he started to eat the corners on a few of the cards! :)I look forward to buying more of these flash card sets as he gets older. Such a fun learning activity for him!

These are very sturdy and you can tell they took into consideration that the targeted audience was indeed children so they didn't make a cheap product. I bought these over a yr or more ago for my son and they are in like new condition now and I'm having my daughter use them. You can't go wrong with these!
