When she started slipping out at midnight to go into the woods and be with English who met to drink and smoke. Michael went with her just to guard her if needed not knowing she was making plans to run away. See just wanted to get away from her strict parents and see what was out there. This was good story.

Unlike most Amish fiction, this book doesn't delve into the differences between the Amish and outsiders nor try to explain why they live as they do. It focuses mostly on teenage Emma Lapp who laments her lack of a running around period and chafes under the strictness of her father. Emma's older sister was killed during her running around period. Fear of it happening again has made Emma's father deny her the usual running around time granted to most Amish teenagers. Emma doesn't see how she can choose to stay in the community if she doesn't know what else is out there. She's been sneaking to the woods on Saturday nights to hang out with outsiders who meet there to drink. One has promised to take her to the city. Michael is Emma's neighbor. He loves her but hasn't yet told her. He fears he's waited too long when he sees how entranced she is with the thought of going to the city. Can his love change Emma's mind?

Emma struggles with the way her father protects her to much. Emma and Michael's friendship is really special. The secret her parents keep from her effects Emma's life. When she learns of the secret she finally understands why her parents are over protective. Watching Michael protect Emma is truly remarkable. You will feel God working throughout this whole book.

I totally enjoyed reading about Emma and her dilemma. Michael was a great best friend during this book. I really liked Michael and was glad to see the morals and values stayed true to what I've read in "Amish" stories. I do enjoy reading this author and definitely recommend this book.
