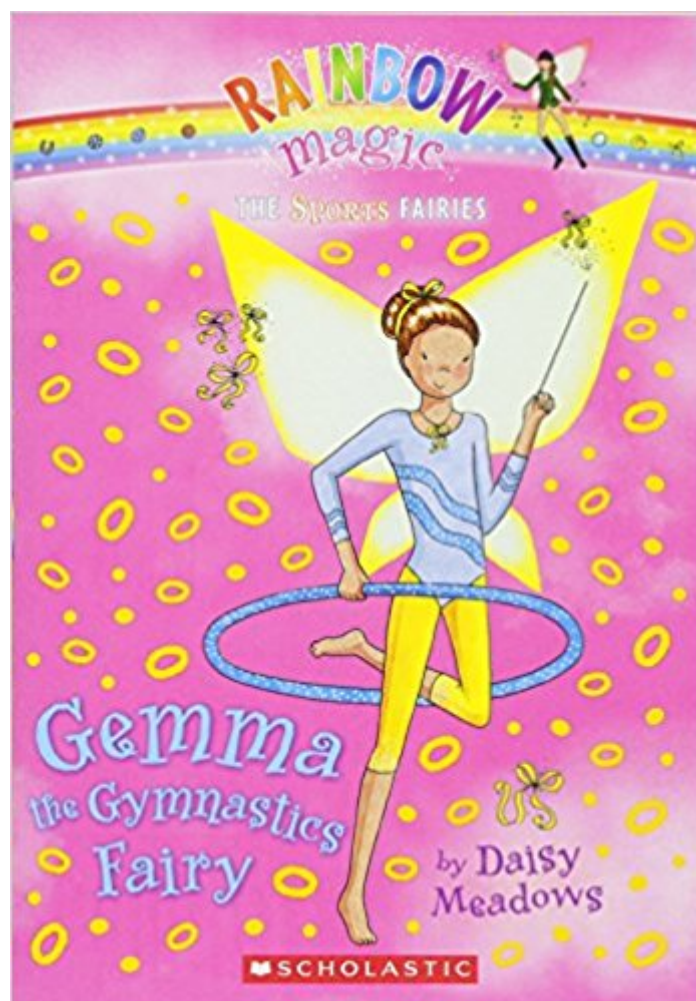

My girl Loved it!! Easy enough to read with just a bit of a challenge. I am trying to get an outside girl interested in reading and she read this. I had promised her that after she read it then we would go and play fairies outside as her reward. She wanted to read another! I was pleased about that since she had been having problems in her reading class. I guess all I needed to do was find something she wanted to read! We found it here!

The subject material is pretty fluffy. Personally I get annoyed by "girly" products that make it seem as if true conflict never exists in a girly world. But I understand the reason for it and the good news about this whole series is that there is very little in there to trouble most parents. The content is whitewashed thoroughly. My daughter has probably read 20 of these books (there are many many many more) from varying series and so far I haven't seen anything to be of concern. And she enjoyed them enough to want to read more - excellent news for the parent of a child who isn't an avid reader! They are good practice for young readers (probably around 1st/2nd grade) but any older than that will not be challenged and will get bored quickly.

So they (Kirsty and Rachel) heard that Gemma and the other sport fairy's lost all there sport equipment. So they were walking around there school and saw sploches of green. They walked in and saw Jack Frosts goblins who were practicing for the fairy games. They saw a goblin who was really tall with Gemma's hula hoop. They saw a sparkle of silver and gold shining in the corner of the sport equipment for gym games. They went over to the corner and picked up all the equipment and saw Gemma . She saw the goblin with her hoop. Kirsty and Rachel had an idea of an obstacle course. They told them what to do. They said at the end" try to throw the hula hoop at me or Rachel". The tallest goblin was next when he came to the last part. He was about to throw it but said"throwing a hula hoop at you is not a sport". They were like um well I thought it would be fun to do with you so you can practice. They were like Gemma help! So she helped first by grabbing the hula hoop and shrinking it. And then shrinking them. They went to the fairy land games. They talked to the king and queen and said"thank you"! All the fairy's that they helped said"thank you".
