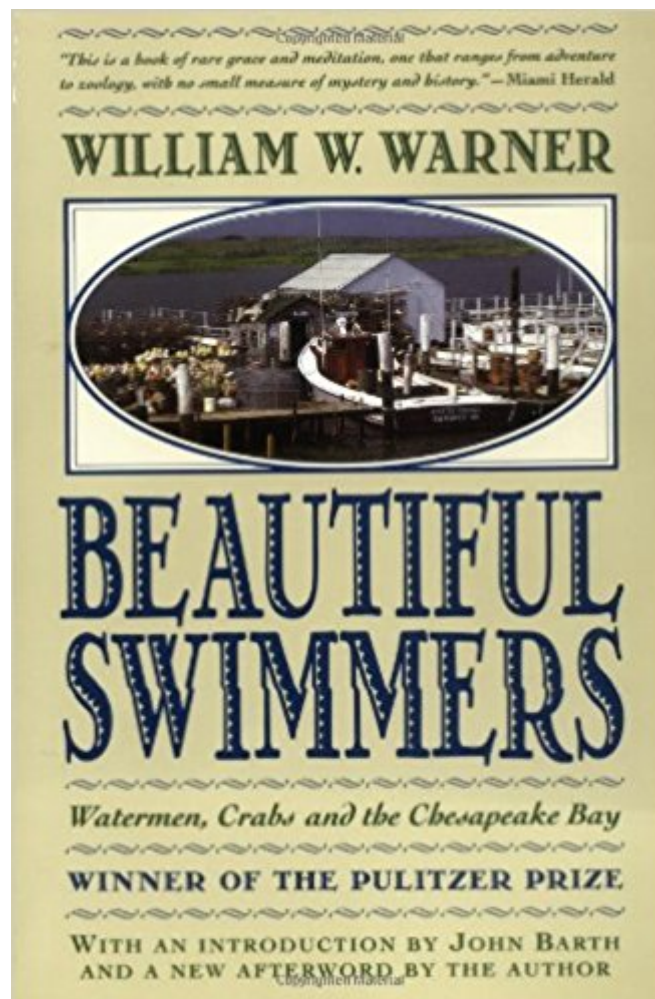

I have owned this book for a long time, but I usually take it off the bookshelf about once a year to read and enjoy it again. William W. Warner definitely hit a home run with this book!
