As one who has always been fascinated by Hebrew and its seemingly undecipherable writing system, I had tried many books over the years and found them too uninteresting. Not so with this book by Gary Ghaller entitled "Simply Learn Hebrew". It is presented in a way that any beginner will find it easy to progress and the references to expand on the knowledge gained by the text presented are most valuable. Well done. Great learning tool.

Fascinating Lessons, expertly built up, well explained, nice price. Four stars, instead of five, for two reasons:- linked videos will not play from Kindle Fire HDX; the author does mention they should be watched on a PC. inconvenient nonetheless.- again, regarding using the book on the Kindle Fire HDX, the Hebrew characters appear small, as a single illustration. They zoom as such, but grainy, and without accompanying text. The book renders good on Kindle Paperwhite 2, but the Hebrew characters could be sharper still. The author gives only some pronunciation answer keys in the beginning, then omits them. pity. He does announce that in the first part of the book. Be aware, that this course will teach to read and pronounce Hebrew without understanding the meaning. I enjoy the lessons a lot, the recommendations above would make it perfect! Thanks to the author for making this available, five stars for opening up this new world to us. The links to explanatory character background are appreciated.

It's been 54 years since I was able to read Hebrew. I am basically starting to read the language from point zero. I am going a little slower than the 14 days that the author says we should take but I am learning... The vowels are giving me a bit of trouble but by repetition I am learning how they work too. I think that by adhering to my pace I will be able to read the language and then I can start working on the vocabulary so as to actually learn Hebrew. My big objection to learning Hebrew 50+

years ago was that we were only learning how to read sounds which made no sense to us. I am a bit wiser now and know what I want to do and this book is teaching me how. I wish the rest of the video's would be complete and put online as promised by the author. In the later chapters when I pronounce something I do not know if I am correct or not and if my pronunciation is wrong then I am not learning anything. I would have given it a higher rating had the video's been finished but in the present state it's like a book with the last 4 chapters being omitted.

I was enjoying learning through this book, which references to videos on the author's blog, after few videos they haven't been updated and book seems to be incomplete because of the lack of videos.

I am a fairly smart person, have studied other languages, have a native Hebrew speaker for a boyfriend, and I was STILL confused by this book. By page 6 I was completely lost, and resorted to sending screen shots to my boyfriend and asking for help. He had to point out that some critical pieces of information were left out, making following along almost impossible. I'm going to Israel in 4 months and need something more effective than this. Going to buy something else.

Not as thorough or well-explained as I would want.

This is exactly what I wanted . Easy to follow. It would seem very hard to learn but it wasn't. Highly recommend this course and the author.

I've rented books from the library and score of online content, and nothing beat out this one for simplicity. What made me really buy this book was his videos that are posted online that I had been watching. Those videos took my ten year "TRY" of learning Hebrew to a practically overnight success. Without them I would still be on the 7th letter of the aleph bet.
