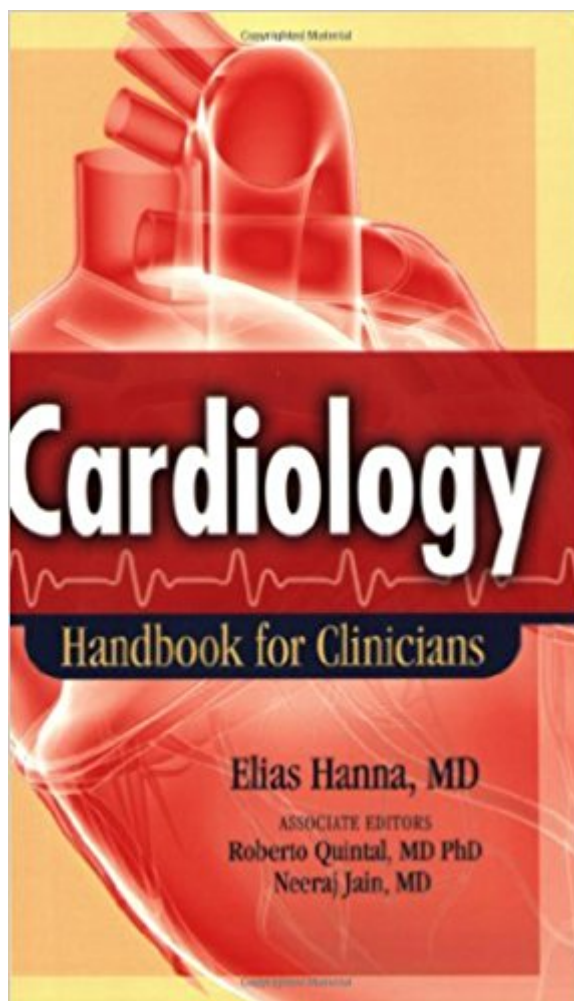

Elias Hanna has written a book that is remarkable in several ways: First, it is a single- authored text, which is a rarity in the 21st century for a work covering a field as broad as cardiology. Second, true to its title, Cardiology: Handbook for Clinicians provides quick reference to various topics yet covers each in a thorough manner. This makes it user friendly in our world of rapidly expanding knowledge and seemingly shrinking time. Third, the book is an appropriate reference for persons in various stages of learning, from the medical student to the practicing cardiologist a range of interest much desired by authors and publishers, but rarely achieved.
