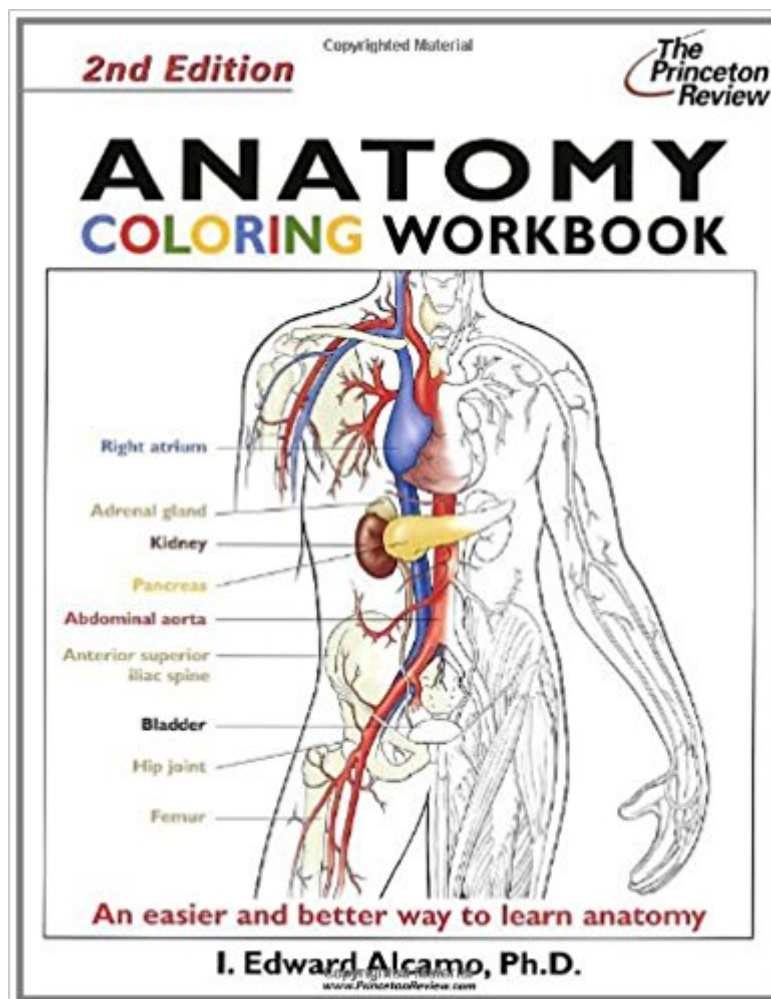




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Anatomy Coloring Workbook, Second Edition (Bk. 2)
