

This is our second visit with "Longshot" and it is another quick and fun romp, this time to the goldfields of southwestern Montana. The characters are finely drawn, the dialog is believable, and the settings are great. I'm sure my own enjoyment was enhanced by familiarity with these settings but they are nicely backdated to support the story. It is also fun that improbable historical characters

pop up in very probable ways. Henry Plummer, especially, gets a markedly different treatment than local history would have. Perhaps an enticement into the next tale? These are fun reads. Hurry with the next one Keith, but do so with your proper sense of the history intact!

The first book I read that was written by Keith Baker was the Longshot from Missouri. It was very interesting with accurate history even though it was fiction. I'm glad he continued the saga with Longshot into The West. His manner of writing is interesting and I believe it will keep anyone's attention that is interested in adventure during the period these books were written. I am starting on the third book and looking forward to the history it will bring to life. I'm not sure how many books he has written, but I plan to follow up on other books that he has written. I really enjoyed this book. I was born and raised in western Montana and when my dad didn't make it back home from WW2 was raised by my grandfather, who had been one of last mountain men. From him, I heard many tales of the early gold camps, not Bannock. But in reading this book I realized that it was the tip of the mountain of gold. Silver and Copper yet to come. Prior to this., I had thought Virginia City was first.

I have read most of longshot series , but I was confused about something. I recall Ose-Asey being in a later book but saw no intro except all of a sudden in chapter 5 page 80 he showed up killing the cat that attacked their horse. In the previous chapter WaHaya was going to guide them in Wills absence. Did I miss something, just confused in Austin....series has been Refreshing over some other westerns I have read.

I've read a lot of books since I've retired. One of the most difficult things that authors have to achieve when writing a book is introducing the characters and setting up the plot. Which stories getting more complex it becomes more difficult to get the setup correctly communicated. While Mr. Baker did OK I did occasionally wonder who this or that character was and how they were connected to the story. That said I enjoyed the travel portions that involved the main character and his associates. Some of their encounters out there in the middle of nowhere were very perilous and kept me reading longer than I should have. All in all I thought that this was a good read.

This is the second of the "Longshot" books that I have read. I enjoy them and they have a nice story

line but at some point, they just end. I like them but I think the author could expand them and not just end them.
